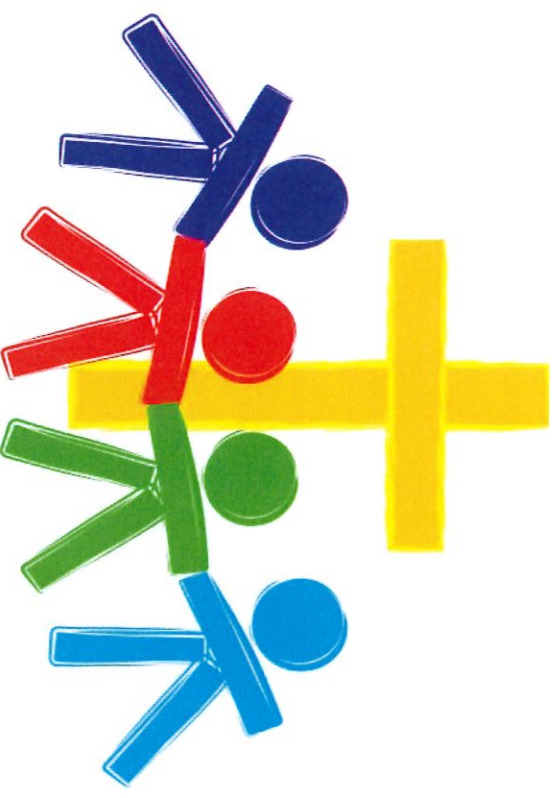


- **Christian Men's Fellowship**

CLASSES FOR

CHILDREN AND YOUTH

- **Nursery** (Birth to Age 2)
Our babies and toddlers are lovingly cared for by Kyla Brooks and volunteers in a bright, colorful, child-friendly environment. Open during the Sunday School hour and both Sunday worship services, the nursery is located behind the church office area, right next to the library.
- **Pre-K/Grade 3** (Ages 3-9)
Preschool and early elementary children will love learning about God's love for them, favorite Bible stories, and the life of Jesus. Lessons may include a Bible story, crafts, games, and snacks. The primary classroom is located in the Christian Education Wing, and teachers are Barbara Bancroft and Gina Mckenney.
- **Juniors** (Grades 4-7)
This class welcomes children in grades four through seven, with a focus on learning to use the Bible and application of Bible lessons to daily life. It may include Bible stories, crafts, and snacks. The junior room is located in the Christian Education Wing, and the teachers are Robin Blanchard and Kelsey Clark.
- **Seniors** (Grades 8-12)
Our senior high class offers Bible lessons designed to help youth understand scripture and apply it to their daily lives. The senior Sunday School room is located in the Christian Education Wing. Teachers are Russ and Cindy Johnson, Diane Clark, and Cathy Vaden.

CLASSES FOR ADULTS

- **The Parlor Class**
This class will be studying the Sermon on the Mount. They will meet in the library, and will be taught by Jamie McDonald and Danny Simmons.
- **The Fellowship Class**
Join a diverse group of individuals and couples who come together to study the Bible. We use the Adult Bible Studies series of quarterly booklets. The lessons in this quarter unify around the theme of "Freedom" and cover 'Rescue,' 'Justice,' and 'Faithful Conversations.' Lesson scriptures come from both Old and New Testaments. Open class discussion is welcomed. The Fellowship Class meets in the Christian Education wing and is taught by Kitten Whitlow.
- **The Sojourners Class**
This will be a "hybrid" class, meeting in-person while continuing with Zoom for those who are out of town or who feel more comfortable with Zoom. Some may go back and forth with Zoom and in-person, depending on their situation. Our study for this fall will be the smaller books of the New Testament, such as I, II & III John, I & II Peter, Jude, Philemon, Titus and I & II Timothy. Some of these letters are less than a page long. They are sometimes referred to as the Catholic Letters, with "Catholic" referring to the church universal rather than the Catholic Church. We may then study Hebrews and/or James. Teachers for this class will be Susan Deihl, Cathy Law, and Sara Reese.
